NCCC was formed to encourage interactivity between Corvette clubs. It operates the sanction program to provide uniform and fair standards for competition events sponsored by individual Corvette clubs. The NCCC includes 16 regions that encompass the United States. The national membership comprised of more than 17,350 members. CPCC is part of the East Region that includes Corvette Clubs located in Eastern Pennsylvania, Maryland, Deleware, New Jersey, Washington, D.C., West Virginia and Virginia. The East Region currently has 29 clubs and over 2,600 members.
